TOSSUPS

TOSSUP 1 -

The only military actions taken during his reign were to repel the Welsh and to assist Malcolm the Third of Scotland against MacBeth. The son of Ethelred The Unready and Emma, he succeeded his half-brother Hardecanute in 1042. With no heir, he promised the throne to William of Normandy, but recanted on his deathbed. Canonized in 1161--FTP--what English monarch had the change of heart that led to the Norman invasion?

ANSWER: _EDWARD THE CONFESSOR_

TOSSUP 2

Its preface states that "the United States themselves are essentially the greatest poem." First published in 1855, it was revised and augmented every few years until the poet's 1892 death. Its first edition contained twelve untilted poems, the longest of which became known as "Song of Myself." FTP--name this Walt Whitman anthology, an excellent gift.

ANSWER: _LEAVES OF GRASS_

TOSSUP 3

It consists of both a helical chain and a ring complex made with a porphyrin compound and iron. Its production requires vitamin B-12, folic acid and iron. Produced in the bone marrow and broken down by the spleen, it transports nitric oxide through the body. FTP--name this red-pigmented protein.

ANSWER: HEMOGLOBIN

TOSSUP 4

The Art Institute of Chicago awarded this painting a prize at its 1930 exhibition, then bought it for \$300. The artist's 30-year-old sister, Nan, and his 62-year-old dentist, Dr. B. H. McKeeby, posed in front of a house in rural Iowa. A pitchfork is the defining prop of--FTP--what Grant Wood masterpiece?

TOSSUP 5

A mold or die; The principle metal in an alloy; The womb; A binding substance; The network of intersections between input and output leads, and; The solid matter surrounding a fossil or crystal. FTP, what six-letter word describes all of these things, as well as a rectangular array of numbers?

ANSWER: _MATRIX_

Born and raised near Worcester [WOO-ster], England, he did much of his learning in his father's music store. His works "The Apostles", "The Kingdom" and "The Dream of Gerontius" represent the apex of the British oratorio. Rising to prominence in 1899 with "The Enigma Variations"——FTP-—who composed the commencement staple, "Pomp and Circumstance"?

ANSWER: Edward _ELGAR_

TOSSUP 7

In classical mythology he personified the morning star, the planet Venus at daybreak. In art he bears a torch, appropriate since his name means "light bearer" in Latin. The only biblical use of the name is in Isaiah and refers to the meteoric fall of the King of Babylon. FTP--whom does Dante's _Inferno_ place as ruler of hell?

ANSWER: LUCIFER [do not accept Satan, etc.]

TOSSUP 8

This daughter of Hyperion and Thia bore 53 daughters of her own, as well as one son, Narcissus. She fell in love with the handsome shepherd Endymion, lulling him into eternal sleep so that he could never leave her and would remain ageless and deathless. The sister of Eos and twin of Helios--FTP--name this Greek goddess of the moon.

ANSWER: _SELENE_

TOSSUP 9

It has existed in some form since about 3000 BC. James Legge produced the first English translation of it in the 1880s as part of his _Sacred Books of the East_. Consisting of 64 six-line hexagrams and explanations of their meaning--FTP--what Taoist divination and philosophy text is often called the Book of Change?

ANSWER: _I CHING_ (prompt on "Book of Change")

TOSSUP 10

They were the first act to release an album from the reactivated Monument Records, part of Sony Music Nashville. Natalie Maines sings lead vocal; Emily Erwin plays dobro and guitar; and Martie Seidel plays fiddle and mandolin. Their debut album, _Wide Open Spaces_, hit #2 on the Top Country Albums chart. FTP--what all-girl Texas band had hits with "I Can Love You Better" and "There's Your Trouble"?

ANSWER: DIXIE CHICKS

TOSSUP 11

In December 1997, Secretary of State Madeleine Albright praised this central African nation as a "beacon of hope". Under President Yoweri Musveni [yo-WHERE-ee moos-VEN-ee], it has seen strong economic growth, an independent press and success in enfranchising women, a far cry from dictatorship by an alleged cannibal. FTP-- name this nation that was ruled from 1971 to 1979 by Idi Amin.

ANSWER: _UGANDA_

TOSSUP 12

Although its purpose was to prepare for war against the French by shoring up the relationship between Iroquois Indians and the colonies, it is better known for Benjamin Franklin's proposition that the colonies form a self-governing federation under his Plan of Union. FTP--what 1754 Congress took its name from a city in New York?

ANSWER: _ALBANY_ Congress

TOSSUP 13

This king, whose name translates to "ruler over heroes," put down revolts in Egypt and Babylon, where he razed the walls and plundered the city. He invaded Greece but was defeated at the Battle of Salamis in 480 B.C. His mother, Atossa, was daughter of Cyrus the Great. FTP--what Persian, son of Darius the First, ruled from 486 to 465?

ANSWER: _XERXES [ZURK-sees] the First

TOSSUP 14

Minor characters include Lord Byron, Jacques Casanova and Don Quixote. The protagonist, Kilroy, is a lightweight boxing champion with "a heart the size of a baby's head." The dried-up fountain in the middle of the title village represents the hopelessness of a place where money has destroyed sincerity, love and kindness. The title of--FTP--what 1953 Tennessee Williams play is Spanish for "royal road"?

ANSWER: _CAMINO REAL_ [ca-MEE-no ray-AL]

TOSSUP 15

Its diameter is about 75 thousand miles and its volume would enclose almost 800 earth-sized bodies. An internal rotation period of less than 11 hours accounts for its oblate shape and equatorial bulge. Its Great White Spot can be seen from earth every 30 years but Galileo was the first to notice its best known feature. FTP--name this gaseous, ringed planet.

ANSWER: _SATURN_

TOSSUP 16

It is only the 77th most abundant element in the Earth's crust, but its presence is evidence of a meteor that may have wiped out the dinosaurs. Discovered in 1804 by Smithson Tennant, its atomic number is also 77. Contrary to recent ads--FTP--what element does NOT have six dots shaped like the big dipper as its chemical symbol?

ANSWER: _IR_idium

TOSSUP 17

This Austrian physician, educated at Vienna University, coined the phrase "animal magnetism," believing it to exercise incredible power over the human body. In 1785 the French government reviewed his treatment of neurotic patients, often with iron magnets, and found his methods questionable. FTP--for whom was a synonym of hypnotism coined?

TOSSUP 18

Johannes Rebmann and Ludwig Krapf discovered it in 1848. A ridge connects its two peaks, the Mawenzi and the Kibo. Coffee plantations and members of the Masai inhabit its lower part. Snow covers--FTP--what inactive volcano on the plains of northeast Tanzania?

ANSWER: KILIMANJARO

TOSSUP 19

The president and CEO of Touchdown Products, a health-food company, he has his own beverage, Pro Flow 100% Natural Spring Water. Briefly a Denver Bronco before his 1988 retirement, he is fourth on the NFL's career rushing list with 13,259 yards. A 1976 Heisman Trophy winner at Pitt--for 10 points--name this longtime Dallas Cowboy.

ANSWER: Tony _DORSETT_

TOSSUP 20

A police officer may cross jurisdictional lines to arrest, or make a warrantless search of, a fleeing suspect. Any person may use reasonable force to retake property that has just been taken. When preceded by "fresh" or "hot"--FTP--what seven-letter word refers to this legal situation?

ANSWER: PURSUIT

TOSSUP 21

He built his estate, Seawood, in Kennebunkport, Maine, but this writer was a Hoosier at heart. "The Gentleman From Indiana", his first novel, was published four years before his election to Indiana's General Assembly.
