

1. Summoned by the spell "Morsmordre," this sign was set above the houses where Voldemort's supporters had recently killed someone. Consequently, it caused widespread panic when it appeared in the sky above the Quidditch World Cup. FTP, give the name of this sign, a skull composed of emerald stars with a serpent protruding from the mouth like a tongue.

The Dark Mark

2. His more innocuous hobbies include chamber music and tenpin bowling, but he is particularly famous for his defeat of the dark wizard Grindelwald in 1945, the discovery of the twelve uses of dragon's blood, and his work on alchemy with his partner, Nicholas Flamel. FTP, name this man who is considered by many to be the greatest wizard of modern times, currently the Headmaster at Hogwarts.

Albus Dumbledore

3. If you are this kind of wizard, you are supposed to be registered with the Ministry of Magic since the transformation can go terribly wrong. However, there appear to be an awful lot of unregistered ones running around out there. Rita Skeeter uses the ability to dig up scandalous stories, and Sirius Black and James Potter were also able to develop the talent. FTP, name this kind of wizard, exemplified by Professor McGonagall's ability to turn into a bespectacled cat.

Animagi (also accept the singular Animagus)

4. This friend of Piers Polkiss received 39 presents for his eleventh birthday. In the books, he has blond hair, so purists are upset that he is played by a dark-haired actor in the movie. He's had a number of odd medical problems in recent years, including a tongue swollen to be four feet long and a pig's tail that had to be surgically removed from his bottom. FTP, name this boy who Harry thinks looks like a pig in a wig.

Dudley Dursley

5. Harry first encounters these on his inaugural trip to Hogwarts. They live up to their name, and thus are something of a risk to eat. The brand includes such innocuous flavors as chocolate and peppermint, more unusual ones like curry and spinach, and truly scary ones like tripe and earwax. FTP, name this magical candy, which is now being produced for the Muggle world by the Jelly Belly company.

Bertie Bott's Every Flavour Beans (prompt on partial answer)

6. For Parvati Patil, it becomes a mummy, while Professor Lupin sees it as a full moon. For Ron, it's a big spider, and he teases Hermione that it would appear to her as a piece of homework that only got nine out of ten. You might expect that Harry would see it as Lord Voldemort, but it looks like a dementor instead, causing Professor Lupin to say that Harry is

most afraid of being afraid. FTP, name this being which becomes confused in a large group of people and can be destroyed when you laugh at it.

Boggart

7. When you're finished using it, just tap it with your wand and say "Mischief Managed!" and it will wipe itself clean. To use it again, say the incantation "I solemnly swear that I am up to no good." Not too surprising, then, that the Weasley twins were the ones who found it in Argus Filch's office and then gave it to Harry. FTP, name this magical piece of parchment that shows Hogwarts and its grounds, complete with labeled, moving dots to represent everyone inside.

The Marauder's Map

8. In only her second correct prediction ever, she proclaims, "Tonight, before midnight, the servant will break free and set out to rejoin his master." Despite the adulation of students like Lavender Brown and Parvati Patil, though, most of her magic seems like melodramatic posturing. FTP, name this thin, bejeweled, bespectacled woman who looks like an insect and teaches Divination at Hogwarts.

Professor Sibyll Trelawney (Accept either first or last name)

9. This tall, thin, black-haired boy had a difficult childhood, as his Muggle father refused to acknowledge him and he was sent to an orphanage after his mother died. He did well at school, becoming Head Boy and what Dumbledore called "the most brilliant student Hogwarts has ever known." Instead of using that power for good, though, he killed his father and grandparents and then became the most feared Dark wizard in history. FTP, identify this boy whose full name is an anagram for "I am Lord Voldemort."

Tom Marvolo Riddle (prompt on Lord Voldemort)

10. Planted at Hogwarts the year that Remus Lupin arrived, it guards a passage from the school grounds that emerges in the Shrieking Shack. It got somewhat damaged when Ron and Harry drove Mr. Weasley's flying car into it at the beginning of their second year, but it managed to inflict considerable damage to the car as well. If you're small, like Crookshanks the cat, you can reach the spot on the trunk which temporarily stops it from moving. FTP, name this tree, which might cause those who come in contact with it to weep.

Whomping Willow

11. She's often visited by her friend Violet, a wizened witch who lives near the Great Hall. In Harry's third year, she has a nervous breakdown after an attack by Sirius Black, and had to be temporarily replaced by Sir Cadogan. Most of the time, however, she performs her duties admirably, coming up with passwords that aren't too confusing and keeping out those who don't know them. FTP, give the somewhat generic name of this woman, the portrait who guards the entrance to the Gryffindor common room.

The Fat Lady

12. Despite the fact that Hermione can't remember the name of his most famous maneuver, and that he pronounces her name "Herm-own-ninny," they have a little romantic thing going during the fourth year, and they attend the Christmas ball together. He's duck-footed and round-shouldered, but is much more graceful when on a broomstick. FTP, name this Durmstrang student, also the Seeker for the Bulgarian national team, who caught the Golden Snitch at the Quidditch World Cup.

Viktor Krum

13. Harry first encounters a member of this species staring at him with green, tennis ball-sized eyes from a hedge at 4 Privet Drive. These overly obsequious beings seem oppressed, but have absolutely no interest in Hermione's attempt to form S.P.E.W. In fact, Winky becomes depressed and goes on a sort of drinking binge after being freed by her master. Only Dobby seems to relish freedom, and he's looked at by the rest of his species as kind of a freak because of it. FTP, give the name of this type of being, bound to serve one family until given clothes.

House-elves

14. When this process goes wrong, it's called being splinched, which means that half of you is in one place and half in the other, and neither half can move until the Accidental Magic Reversal Squad arrives and unites the different pieces again. Because it's so difficult, you must be of age and pass a test in order to get a license if you wish to do it. As Hermione keeps pointing out, there are spells on Hogwarts to prevent anyone from doing it within the grounds. FTP, name this form of magic transportation.

Apparition (also accept the verb, to apparate)

15. This Seeker for the Ravenclaw team makes Harry feel a little "funny" when he first gets to know her. During his fourth year, he finally gets up the nerve to ask her to the Yule Ball, only to find that heartthrob Cedric Diggory has gotten there first. She's last seen sobbing over Cedric at the final banquet in the fourth year, and it remains to be seen whether she'll renew a possible interest in Harry. FTP, name this student, Harry's first crush.

Cho Chang

16. Ron's Uncle Bilius saw one and died twenty-four hours later. Harry first sees a picture of one on the cover of *Death Omens: What to Do When You Know the Worst Is Coming*, and then starts to think he's seeing it in various places on the Hogwarts grounds. Luckily for him, it's just Sirius in his animal form. FTP, give the name for this big black dog that many wizards think forebodes death.

The Grim

17. Presided over by toothless landlord Tom, it provides the passageway from Muggle London into magic London. If you tap the third brick from the left above the trash bin in its back yard, a gateway opens to Diagon Alley. Harry meets Professor Quirrell here and later stays as a lodger for a few weeks after he blows up Aunt Marge and runs away from the Dursleys'. FTP, name this Holiday Inn of the wizarding world.

The Leaky Cauldron

18. His mother and father are now in St. Mungo's Hospital for Magical Maladies and Injuries, having been driven insane after being tortured by Barty Crouch and his cohorts. Perhaps this is one of the reasons that he's always had trouble with magic, making his grandmother constantly upset with him. His one strong subject is Herbology, and he can show bravery at times, causing Dumbledore to award him enough points for Gryffindor to win the House Cup in his first year. FTP, name this fellow student of Harry, Ron, and Hermione.

Neville Longbottom

19. He is always seen wearing an odd assortment of clothes: a pinstriped suit, a scarlet tie, a long black cloak, purple pointed boots, and a lime-green bowler hat. His worried expression gives an idea of the amount of responsibility he has, but he seems ineffectual at best and corrupt at worst, being too inclined to listen to Lucius Malfoy and too worried about maintaining his office to believe that Voldemort has returned to power. FTP, name this Minister of Magic.

Cornelius Fudge

20. When Harry first meets him, he's decrepit-looking, resembles a plucked turkey, and is making gagging noises. However, he proves to be a faithful friend, bringing Harry the sword with which he kills the basilisk and then healing Harry's wounds with his tears. His song also brings strength, and one of his feathers forms the core of Harry's wand. FTP, name this pet of Dumbledore's whom Harry first encounters on a Burning Day.

Fawkes

21. Granted, being killed by a basilisk wouldn't put anyone in the best of moods, but she's positively mopey, preferring to haunt the place she died and occasionally travel through the pipes to ogle Cedric Diggory while he's bathing. However, she is helpful in solving the mystery of the Chamber of Secrets as well as figuring out Harry's second task in the Triwizard Tournament. FTP, name this lugubrious ghost who haunts a girls' bathroom.

Moaning Myrtle

22. It's a very rare talent; Salazar Slytherin, Lord Voldemort, and Harry Potter are three of the people known to be able to speak it. Though Harry exhibits the ability before he even knows he is a wizard, he doesn't realize the full meaning of it until he chases a snake away from Justin Finch-Fletchley during the dueling club. FTP, what is this language, which is naturally spoken by some wizards and allows them to communicate with snakes?
