1. In a short film centered on one track off this album, the singer brings a female phoenix to see fireworks and they later attend a dinner party where everyone wears white. The music video for one song off this album features identical women with horns flanking the singer who stands in front of a long row of columns. Swizz Beats sings "one hand in the air, if you don't really care" in one song off this album. In one track off this album, the singer says that "no one man should have all that power" and on another Rihanna requests that you "turn up the lights in here, baby, extra bright, I want ya'll to see this." For 10 points, name this Kanye West album featuring the tracks "Power" and "All of the Lights."

ANSWER: My Beautiful Dark Twisted Fantasy

2. This singer compiled three live show recordings for *The Tigers Have Spoken*. A band titled for this singer and her boyfriends released the albums "The Virginian" and "Furnace Room Lullaby." This lead singer of "These Are the Fables" was replaced by Kathryn Calder for most of the *Twin Cinema* tour. "Hold On, Hold On" is a track off this singer's album *Fox Confessor Brings the Flood* which was followed by the releases of *Middle Cyclone* and *The Worse Things Get, the Harder I Fight, the Harder I Fight, the More I Love You*. For 10 points, name this female singer-songwriter who provided leading vocals for the New Pornographers.

ANSWER: Neko Case

3. After his head is slammed into a table, this character advises his assailant not to go for the head first because "the victim gets all fuzzy." After robbing a mafia-held bank, this character kills his colleagues. This character's appearance is either due to having a wife who got in trouble with loan sharks or his drunkard father attacking his mother with a knife. This character zips himself up in a body bag to get to Gambol and pretends to be a nurse to reach Harvey Dent and convince him to get revenge. Heath Ledger won a posthumous Academy Award for his portrayal of this character. For 10 points, name this clown-like Batman villain.

ANSWER: The **Joker**

- 4. This character's sister thinks that Seattle is a neighborhood in Washington, D.C. and doesn't understand why people like abstract art more than cat paintings. Instead of applying for a job, this character opts for getting cheese fries. Due to high levels of uranium in the water supply, this character moves from Highland to Lawndale. This character designs a science experiment about whether idiocy is genetic or environmental and uses Beavis and Butthead as her subjects. This character has a crush on Trent, the older brother of her best friend Jane Lane. For 10 points, name this teenage girl that appears on an eponymous animated MTV show satirizing high school life. ANSWER: **Daria**
- 5. One actor from this show went on to play Mitch in *Waiting* and co-wrote *Horrible Bosses*. The lead singer of Feedback is revealed to be Rosso the guidance counselor on one episode of this show. One character on this show purchases a neon blue disco suit and is forced to run around the school naked in a different incident. One character on this show asks the mentally handicapped student Eli to the Homecoming Dance right before he breaks his arm. After replacing the real keg with a fake one on an episode of this show, Bill drinks the real keg and watches *Dallas*. Lindsay begins dating a character portrayed by Jason Segal in this show which also stars James Franco and Seth Rogen. For 10 points, name this one-season NBC show centering on Lindsay and Sam Weir and their friends who are all high school outcasts.

ANSWER: Freaks and Geeks

6. A sheriff in this movie interrupts a kiss because a perfectly good cake was left behind. The protagonist of this movie asks her husband if they ran out of soap at the Piggly Wiggly and empties their joint checking account. Bobby Ray pretends to be Melanie's cousin in this movie to give a tour to an assistant posing as a reporter from the *New York Post*. The protagonist of this film becomes a fashion designer and gets engaged to the son of the Mayor of New York but leaves him at the altar after realizing she hasn't signed the divorce papers and goes to the beach to kiss her childhood love. For 10 points, name this romantic comedy starring Reese Witherspoon that shares its name with a Lynyrd Skynyrd song about a Southern state.

ANSWER: Sweet Home Alabama

7. This failed politician thinks America is in the midst of a "baby holocaust" and once attempted to pass a bill making abortion punishable by the death penalty. This person loves Girl Scout cookies but supports a boycott because of transgender girls being allowed to join in Colorado. This man's son-in-law was accused of animal cruelty after trying to sled over a cat. This man's daughters revealed that he started locking their doors after their brother sexually assaulted them in their sleep and admitted knowing about Josh's assaults since he was 14. For 10 points, name this patriarch of a family featured on 19 Kids and Counting.

ANSWER: Jim Bob **Duggar**

8. One character announces that Taco Tuesday will now be known as Freedom Friday, but will still be on a Tuesday. The protagonist of this film builds a double decker couch when escaping from Cloud Cuckoo Land with Unikitty, Batman, and others. Characters in this film sing "Everything is Awesome" to escape being captured. The Businessman who leads Octan attempts to use Kragle to destroy the world in this movie and must be stopped by the Master Builders including Vitruvius, Wildstyle, and Emmett. For 10 points, name this 2014 animated movie about a brand of interlocking building toys.

ANSWER: The LEGO Movie

9. This youngest cover star for *Teen Vogue* posed naked to raise money for environmental issues in *Natural Beauty* and modeled with her brother Alex for Burberry. In one role, this actress builds a raft to escape her father-in-law and gives birth to twin girls. In another role, this actress is put in jail in the cell next to Lindsay Lohan after repeatedly burglarizing Paris Hilton's house. This actress who played Ila in *Noah* and Nicki in *The Bling Ring* will star opposite Dan Stevens in the upcoming live adaptation of *Beauty and the Beast*. This actress crashed the UN Women website when she announced she would be a Goodwill Ambassador. For 10 points, name this actress who portrayed Hermione Granger in the *Harry Potter* series.

ANSWER: Emma Watson

10. In the music video for one song by this band, a woman is strapped to a hospital bed and remembers being sexually abused as a child before an angel saves her. Three angry teenagers throw mementos into a hill in the music video for one song by this band which opens with the lines "every time we lie awake, after every hit we take." In another song, this band's singer asks "so what if you can see the darkest side of me?" and says no one will ever change him. This band's song "Never Too Late" was released on the album *One-X* which also includes the song "Animal I Have Become." For 10 points, name this Canadian alt-metal band behind "I Hate Everything About You."

ANSWER: Three Days Grace

- 11. The drug dealer Blaine DeBeers asks the title character of this show to supply him with substances from her work with Dr. Ravi Chakrabarti. The main character develops a fear of pigeons in one episode of this show and in another episode she develops a fondness for jazz music and painting. The main character of this show gets infected at a boat party where people take a drug called Utopium and the energy drink company Max Rager is believed to be behind the infections. Liv adopts the personality of murder victims and has flashbacks that help her solve Clive Babineaux's cases on this show. For 10 points, name this CW show about a morgue worker who eats brains. ANSWER: *iZombie*
- 12. One song by this band includes the lines "only love is all maroon" and "sky is womb and she's the moon." That song appears on an album whose title was taken from the show *Northern Exposure* and recorded while the singer had mono at a cabin in Wisconsin. The second album by this band primarily features songs named after towns, such as "Calgary" and "Perth" and received the Best Alternative Music Album award at the 2012 Grammy's. That self-titled album concludes with the track "Beth/Rest." One song by this band tells the listener "I told you to be patient, I told you to be fine" and is featured on their debut album along with "Flume" and "Blindsided." That song is "Skinny Love." For 10 points, name this indie folk band fronted by Justin Vernon whose debut album was *For Emma, Forever Ago*.

ANSWER: Bon Iver

13. The music video for this song is set a "crazy long time ago" and depicts the singer killing a man because he runs out of water to quench her thirst. A guest vocalist on this track compares the singer to Jeffrey Dahmer and notes that

"she can be my Sleeping Beauty." The singer of this song instructs the listener to "make me your Aphrodite" but "don't make me your enemy." The music video for this song features the singer as a Cleopatra-like figure. This song asks the listener if they "wanna play with magic" and asks "baby do you dare to do this?" For 10 points, name this Katy Perry song in which she says she is coming at you like the title animal.

The protagonist of this film receives three chopsticks with his dumplings from the Magic Blue Dragon. The protagonist of this film grabs a man by his necktie to prevent him from committing suicide but lets him jump later. A girl in this film chats online with Evergreen before Joo-Hwan reveals that Evergreen is Woo-Jin. After begging Woo-Jin not to let Mi-Do see the photo album that shows she is his daughter, the protagonist of this film cuts out his tongue. For 10 points, name this film about Dae-Su seeking revenge on his captor after being imprisoned for 15 years.

Michael orchestrates a plan to escape along with the Fox River Eight on this show. For 10 points, name this Fox TV drama about an innocent man on death row attempting to escape jail with the help of his brother.

This group includes failed lawyer Jeff, activist Britta, and Annie, played by Allison Brie. For 10 points, name this group of students at Greendale Community College. ANSWER: the **study group** from *Community* [accept any reasonable equivalents]

20. The protagonist of this movie climbs Crown's Tooth and drinks from the fire falls. Mor'du fails to become human again after wishing to be more powerful than his three brothers in this movie. In this movie, Lord MacIntosh accuses Lord Dingwall of hiding under bridges and being a troll. A curse in this movie is reversed when a cut tapestry is mended. The will-o-the-wisps lead the protagonist of this movie to a woodworkers hut where a witch gives her a cake that transforms Queen Elinor into a bear. The protagonist of this movie competes for her own hand in an archery competition. For 10 points, name this Disney movie about Merida, set in the Scottish highlands. ANSWER: <u>Brave</u>

TB. Men in one music video by this band sob over women's underwear, a chicken, and in various locations across the world after members of this band break up with them. Members of this band play basketball in one music video while singing "you say you will, say you will save me." The title track of this band's debut albums begins "And I got back up, when I lost control over it all, over it all." That album by this band concludes with the track "Running If You Call My Name." This band's singer says "I fumbled it when I came down to the wire" in "The Wire" which was the fourth single off their debut album after "Falling." For 10 points, name this band of sisters whose debut album was *Days Are Gone*.

ANSWER: Haim

1. Name these things about Sam Smith, for 10 points each.

[10] Tom Petty received co-writer credits on Smith's song "Stay With Me" because of it's similarity to this Tom Petty single off *Full Moon Fever*.

ANSWER:"I Won't Back Down"

[10] This shock jock described Sam Smith as ugly, fat, and effeminate on his eponymous radio show.

ANSWER: Howard Stern

[10] Anthony Anderson accepted Sam Smith's BET Award for Best New Artist on his behalf. Anderson stars on this ABC Show about an upper-middle-class African American family.

ANSWER: Black-ish

2. One member of this band wears nothing but leather sleeves to perform and attempts to hit on Principal Mullins. For 10 points each:

[10] Name this band that wins the Battle of the Bands despite the crowd cheering more loudly for the band which performed the song "Teacher's Pet."

ANSWER: No Vacancy

[10] "Teacher's Pet" was performed by this band of students. The band shares its name with the movie in which it appears that stars Jack Black as Dewey Finn.

ANSWER: School of Rock

[10] Dewey has been teaching at Horace Green prep school while impersonating this roommate of his.

ANSWER: Ned Schneebly [accept either]

ANSWER: a truck

5. This actor portrayed Cowboy Curtis on Pee-wee's Playhouse. For 10 points each:

[10] Name this actor who later appeared as Vinnie in *Searching for Bobby Fischer* and portrayed Jason Styles in *Boyz n the Hood*.

ANSWER: Laurence Fishburne

[10] Fishburne portrayed this captain of the Nebuchadnezzar in the Matrix films.

ANSWER: Morpheus

[10] After an interviewer confused him with Laurence Fishburne and said he was in a Super Bowl commercial, this actor purchased a shirt that says "I'm not Laurence Fishburne." This actor was in *Snakes on a Plane*.

ANSWER: Samuel L. Jackson

- 6. This actress said she didn't know what "JFC" stood for during her appearance on Creepy Text Theatre. For 10 points each:
- [10] Name this former porn star whose feature film debut was in *The Girlfriend Experience*.

ANSWER: Sasha Grev

[10] Sasha Grey was on Creepy Text Theatre to promote *Open Windows* in which she co-starred with this actor who portrayed Frodo in *The Lord of the Rings* movies.

ANSWER: Elijah Wood

[10] In this other film, Elijah Wood plays Casey Connor, who discovers that the teachers at his school are controlled by aliens.

ANSWER: The **Faculty**

7. Playable items in this game include "Pooping back and forth. Forever." and "Police brutality." For 10 points each: [10] Name this game in which players complete sentences with offensive or disturbing phrases, similar to Apples to Apples.

ANSWER: Cards Against Humanity

ANSWER: Janelle **Monae**

[10] This debut album by Monae was a follow-up to *Metropolis* and singles released off it include "Tightrope" and "Cold War."

ANSWER: The ArchAndroid

[10] This artist is featured on "Tightrope." This member of Outkast's solo albums include *Sir Lucious Left Foot: The Son of Chico and Dusty*.

ANSWER: Big Boi

- 15. On this show, U-Turn buys seven Priuses for his crew because they're real quiet and good for sneaking up on rival gangs. For 10 points each:
- [10] Name this TV show about the antihero Nancy Botwin who starts selling drugs to maintain her lifestyle in suburban California.

ANSWER: Weeds

As Nick, this actor lights the House of Wax on fire. In one role, this actor plays for the Ravens basketball team and feuds with his half-brother Nathan. This actor sings "Hit Me Baby, One More Time" while enamored with Jamie Lee Curtis's character in *Freaky Friday*. For 10 points, name this actor who played Lucas Scott on *One Tree Hill*.

Peggy Olson starts working as this man's secretary at Sterling Cooper. For 10 points, name this advertising executive played by Jon Hamm on *Mad Men*

6. One character in this movie dropped her shoe into a river when she was little but that river was filled in and is now all apartments. The protagonist of this movie pulls a bicycle out of a customer who gives her an emetic dumpling in exchange. Boh is transformed into a mouse and dances with Kamaji's sootballs. ANSWER: Punch Brothers

5. At the start of one music video based on this song, the singer tells his auntie that he's not still watching *Dancing with the Stars*. Michelle Obama posted a Vine holding a root vegetable with this song playing. In one video based on this song, Lena Dunham says she is doing the title action for reproductive rights and the singer holds a giant blunt. In the music video for this song, a police officer motorboats a woman, a girl twerks on some paper towels, and a man humps a television set after falling through a woman's ceiling. The singer of this song advocates to "fire up that load, another round of shots" before repeating the title question. Interpol asks for this character's help after people are assassinated after using Blue Steel. After working in the coal mines, this character's father says he is not his son after he appears in a commercial as a merman. A Center for Kids Who Can't Read Good and Wanna Learn Other Stuff Too is named for this character after he agrees to work for Mugatu, who brainwashes him to assassinate the Prime Minister of Malaysia when the song "Relax" is played. One character on this show learns urban myths from someone named "Fuzzy Slippers." The protagonist of this show has a crush on Lila and is bullied by Helga. Gerald always wears a red shirt with the number 33 on it on this show. For 10 points, name this animated Nickolodeon series about the title nine-year-old with a football shaped head and funny yellow hair.

ANSWER: Hev Arnold!

8. Mac Miller said even this athlete couldn't "fight the feeling" and RiFF RAFF says he talks "more shit than Judge Judy" or this athlete. This subject of a song by Jay Rock featuring Kendrick Lamar recorded his own rap song "Yep" which he used as entrance music against Big Show. This athlete refuses to wear a pair of underwear more than once and has a fleet of black cars in Miami and white cars in Las Vegas. This creator of the brand The Money Team claims he can fit \$1 million in a hockey bag. This athlete refers to himself in the third person when bragging about beating other competitors like Victor Ortiz and Shane Mosley. For 10 points, name this boxer who fought Manny Pacquiao in the Fight of the Century.

9. This band describes themselves as "the type of people make the club get crunk" and suggests "everybody move to the back of the bus" in one song. This band behind "Rosa Parks" and "Player's Ball" was featured on the UGK track "International Players Anthem (I Choose You)." In one song, this band says that roses smell like poo and in another track they apologize to the title mother for making her daughter cry. Andre 3000 says his baby "don't mess around" and instructs the listener to "shake it like a Polaroid picture" in another song by this band behind "Ms. Jackson." For 10 points, name this hip hop duo that includes Big Boi that sang "Hey Ya."

ANSWER: OutKast

10. A Tumblr page dedicated to these two people features a picture of one of these people on the phone with Michael Cera with superimposed text "What more can I say? Welcome to LA." Some combinations of these to people also feature Khloe Kardashian's husband Odom. One of these singers works at a bakery in a music video that features the other one wearing a black sweatshirt covered in white squares. A mash-up song featuring these two people includes the lines "put your hands up high, hands up high" and "you're gonna miss me when I'm gone" and is called "Poetic." For 10 points, name these two people, one of whom starred in *Pitch Perfect* and the other one who released *Two Pimp a Butterfly*.

ANSWER: Anna Kendrick Lamar

11. The movie *God Speed You! Black Emperor* was about this type of group. In one movie about this type of group, William H. Macy's character Dudley falls in love with the owner of a diner in Madrid, New Mexico. That movie about this type of group stars Tim Allen and Jon Travolta, who go from Cincinnati to California. In an episode of *The Simpsons* about this type of group, Homer wins a dancing contest at Greasers Cafe and Marge teaches Meathook and his friends how to write a resume. SAMCRO is one of these groups whose members include Jax Teller, played by Charlie Hunnam, in the fictional town of Charming. For 10 points, name these types of groups that *Sons of Anarchy* portrays.

12. In one song, the singer of this band tells the title person to "fly this girl as high as you can into the wild blue" and says she wants to "be the only one for miles and miles." In another song, this band describes a girl who needs "room to make her big mistakes" and "needs new faces." This band posed nude for *Entertainment Weekly* covered in slogans like "Saddam's Angels" and "Proud American." This band included "Cowboy Take Me Away" on their album *Fly* which also contained "Goodbye Earl" and their other albums include *Wide Open Spaces*. One member of this band said she was "ashamed that the President of the United States is from Texas" before the US invasion of Iraq. For 10 points, name this all-female country music group.

[10] In this other song from *Beauty and the Beast*, Belle is told to "try the grey stuff, it's delicious!" while being served a multi-course meal.

ANSWER: "Be Our Guest"

[10] In the song "Gaston," this sidekick says "not a bit of him's scraggly or scrawny" and says nobody bites or spits like Gaston.

ANSWER: LeFou

[10] Brody played Jeff Megall's assistant in this satirical movie about Big Tobacco's use of lobbyists and spin tactics.

As Freddie Miles, this actor notes that Dickie doesn't play piano and is killed by Ripley. This actor voiced a character who buys a collection of Noblet figures after winning the lottery and removes the M from his keyboard when his pen pal writes her dissertation on Asperger syndrome. In one role, this actor challenges Gavin to a game of chicken on the ship's masts after Gavin sleeps with Simple Simon's wife. This actor played The Count in *Pirate Radio*. For 10 points, name this actor who starred in *Capote*.

ANSWER: Philip Seymour Hoffman

4. This character says there are four people in the car when ordering at a Wendy's with his friend Jacko. This character claims he can "dance like Fred Astaire" after ordering two beers - one for him, and one for his friend Cyril, who he passes off to Wally. Though legends say he is missing a leg, this character describes it as "more like a lovebite, really." He kisses Donk to make him spill his beer. This character knocks out a thief with a can of soup. He claims to have found three Filipino fishermen inside a shark stomach while at a "boozer" with an off-duty taxi driver in New York. This character, played by Paul Hogan, refuses to hand over his wallet to a mugger and tells him "that's not a knife." For 10 points, name this Australian bushman who fights crocodiles.

D'Angelo Barksdale says that this group "be down here about the bodies" not about people getting high. Wo Fat is the nemesis of Steve McGarrett, a leader of a group named for this

term who frequently says "Book 'em, Danno." For 10 points, name this slang term for the police used in *The Wire* and on a cop show set in Hawai'i.

This show's protagonist's ex-girlfriend Fiona helps him when his assets are frozen and he is left in Miami after a mission in Nigeria. For 10 points, name

Subtitles in a video game franchise with this name include "African Safari," "Tracking Trophies" and "Extended Season." Guards force Steven into an underwater cage filled with rats after he messes up during a game of Russian roulette in a movie with this title. Three friends are sent to Vietnam in a movie with this title starring Robert De Niro, Christopher Walken, and Meryl Streep. 10. The antagonist of this movie is accused of raiding Barry Manilow's wardrobe. One character in this movie tells a joke about a blonde who walks into a bar with a poodle and a two-foot salami. In this movie, a girl makes a cereal and sugar sandwich after throwing her lunch meat on a statue in the library. Allison gets a makeover in this movie and rips the state champion patch off John's letterman jacket. The central character in this movie must write a 1000-word essay defining who they are. "Don't You Forget About Me" plays as Bender raises his fist and walks across the football field at the end of this movie.
