2. This word is the name of a popular dance in Sri Lanka, and a song titled "[this word] Remix Karala" was remixed into the 2011 Sri Lankan Cricket Team's song. Another song with this word in its title claims that this word "esta cumbia," and is by Selena. A song with another conjugation of this word in its title says (\*) "Nothing can stop us tonight" before the title phrase. That song featuring this word in its title also says "Te quiero, amor mio" before the title word is repeated in the chorus. For 10 points, name this word which titles an Enrique Iglesias song, in which it precedes and succeeds the phrase "Let the rhythm take you over."

3. The second episode of the History Channel TV show *UnXplained* is partially set in this location. Some people theorize that symbols at this location indicate that it was used by Rosicrucians, which might make sense because the Rosicrucians also have a museum in the city where this place is located. This place is located across a street named for it from (\*) Santana Row, an upscale residential and commercial district. This location, which survived both the 1906 and Loma Prieta earthquakes, was built by Sarah Lockwood. This movie set a precedent for Emraan Hashmi, leading him to become known as the "serial kisser" due to his work in erotic thrillers. For 10 points, name this movie starring Mallika Sherawat, in which her character agrees to take the blame for the title killing.

5. A recent song by this artist describes a girl as an "asesina" and begins with the phrase "Como te llamas, baby" and features Katy Perry. This artist tried out for the Seattle Mariners before accidentally being shot and giving up on his potential baseball career. In his most famous song, this artist states that his girl rides in (\*) "cars, motorbikes, and limousines." That song by this artist features a refrain in which another singer, Glory, sings "dame mas" of the title substance. This artist collaborated with Luis Fonsi on the song Despacito. For 10 points, name this Puerto Rican "King of Reggaeton," famous for the songs *Con Calma* and *Gasolina*.

ANSWER: **Daddy Yankee**

6. In 2019 this company unveiled plans to construct a "North Tower" near its headquarter connected by a skybridge, the first of its kind in the city where this company is headquartered. In 1992, a founder of this company was kidnapped at gun-point in this company's parking lot. Steve Jobs' failed attempts to

buy this company led him to invest in shares worth 19% of it, leading this company to become the first from Silicon Valley to be profitable in its first year. After leaving the Xerox Palo Alto Research Center, (\*) Charles Geschke founded this company, along with John Warnock. For 10 points, name this software company known for creating a namesake "Illustrator" as well as Photoshop. ANSWER: Adobe Inc.

7. Home Minister Anil Deshmukh tried to prevent a CBI investigation into this event, but was eventually overruled. The death of Disha Salian suspiciously occurred 5 days before this event. As alleged on Republic TV, Dr. Sudhir Gupta admitted that the scene of this event was contaminated, which prevented a thorough investigation. Deepika Padukone and other actresses have been accused of being part of a (\*) drug ring which played some role in this event, which has also spurred debates about nepotism in Bollywood. This event led to the delayed release of the movie *Dil Bechara*. Rhea Chakraborty has been accused of instigating, for 10 points, what June 2020 event in which her boyfriend committed suicide?

8. During this artist's early career, he featured on a Jennifer Lopez song stating the title phrase along with "Dale." In that song, this artist says "That badonka donk is like a trunk full of bass on an old school Chevy" and earlier repeats the phrase (\*) "On the Floor." This artist has frequently collaborated with Indian singer Guru Randhawa, such as in the songs *Slowly Slowly* and *Mueve la Cintura*. The latter of those songs also featured Puerto Rican singer Tito El Bambino, and was part of this artist's most recent album, *Libertad* 548. For 10 points, name this Cuban-American rapper with a stage name referring to a dog breed.

ANSWER: **Pitbull** < Latin American>

9. After leaving this location in 1827, an indigenous alcalde named Estanislao led a failed revolt. Despite the failure of that revolt, Estanislao later taught the Yokuts language at this location. Much of this site had to be rebuilt after an 1868 earthquake, although the quarters of some of this place's inhabitants still survive. This location was founded by Father (\*) Fermin Lasuen, sometimes known as the "forgotten friar," who succeeded Juniperro Serra. A school named after this location was founded after a neighborhood named for this location was incorporated along with 5 others into a city. For 10 points, name this location that names a school where Avinash Iyer leads the quiz bowl team.

10. In the film Orange Mittai, Vijay Sethupathi's character dances to a song originally written for this actress. In another film, this actress portrays the wife of a Christian man who disapproves of her sister-in-law's relationship with a Hindu man. In that film, this actress's character also tries to cover up the crime when her husband is caught raping their maid. A semi-biographical film about this actress sees her tricked into acting for a (\*) pornographic film, after which this actress commits suicide. Vidya Balan portrayed a fictionalized version of this actress in the 2011 film The Dirty Picture. For 10 points, name this Tamil actress famous for her risque roles, whose stage name titles the film Silk Silk Silk.

11. In the beginning of this film, a character describes a fart as a "graduation gift." During that scene in this film, one character says that his father will only give him a car if he takes Economics, before claiming that he "hates economists." During the ending of this film, those two characters reconcile, but

the narration claims that they will never see each other again. The ending of this film features those two characters engaged in a threesome with a character played by (\*) Maribel Verdu, with the two characters

both cheating on their respective girlfriends. A trip to the fictional "Boca del Cielo" beach forms the setting of this film. For 10 points, name this comedy film starring Gael Garcia Bernal and Diego Luna, directed by Alfonso Cuaron.

12. One of these structures named for a skunk is located in Mendocino County. The ghost of a girl who died in a car accident reportedly haunts a canyon that names one of these structures. That canyon, which names one of these structures, is also the site of the former Essanay silent film studios, and contains the elusive "Secret Sidewalk." A group of nine African-American and one white woman were removed from one of these structures called (\*) "Napa Valley Wine" in 2015, sparking controversy. After a woman distracts the title character of this film, claiming that her phone conversations with the police were with her worrisome aunt, the title character of this film claims that her aunt has brought a lot of uncles, noticing the police. Telugu remakes of this film include N.T. Rama Rao's (\*) Yugandhar, as well as a remake of a Tamil remake of this film, Billa. The title character of this film claims that to capture him is not just difficult, but impossible. 14. This character is revealed to have been born in an affluent home the town of Tewkesbury. This character's first appearance sees him unable to focus on his work in a house in Santa Clara. Like Sherlock Holmes, this character is revealed to have a brother with abilities far beyond his own, but who is also agoraphobic and never leaves his home. This character discovers the body of a campaign worker in Sausalito and later (\*) solves the murder of a candidate for mayor. This character's fear of germs leads to him requesting sanitary wipes after every handshake. For 10 points, name this San Francisco detective who is the namesake of a TV series?

ANSWER: **Monk** <Bay Area>

15. This actor presented a TV series called *Seven Deadly Arts with* this actor. This actor gained honorary Canadian citizenship in 2011, but is currently planning to give it up. This actor's lack of success compared to the Khans can be attributed to his choice to star in double-lead films, such as alongside (\*) Suniel Shetty in *Mohra*. This actor also starred alongside Saif Ali Khan in a remake of the American film *Sabrina*. This actor began his career by moving to Bangkok to learn martial arts, supporting himself as a cook. For 10 points, name this Indian actor famous for his action roles, such as in the *Khiladi* series. ANSWER: <u>Akshay Kumar</u> [or <u>Rajeev Hari Om Bhatia</u>]

16. A parody of Jersey Shore aimed at people from this country also stars Yousef Erakat, commonly known as FouseyTube. Carl Stempel, a psychologist at Cal State East Bay, found that in his sample, 45% of these people experienced PTSD. A film about people from this country, which was made by

Aisha Jamal, whose work often focuses on the experiences of people from this country, premiered at the Tiburon International Film Festival. In one film, the character Ravi Varma is killed after being thrown off a cliff near a temple to this deity, and in another film, a mother repeatedly pleads with this deity to give her (\*) sons back, who, like Ravi Varma, are reincarnated. 18. One of these locations was built on a site that was originally a Ford Assembly Factory, and contains an oak tree with a plaque commemorating its history. That one of these locations was the site of a shooting yesterday. It's not a house, but another one of these locations is located opposite the Santana Row, and was merged from 2 of these locations. One of these locations in San Francisco's Japantown is the Japan Center. A direct BART line connects 2 of these locations, the (\*) Bayfair one of these places in San Leandro, and the Stoneridge one of these places in Pleasanton. Westfield operates two of these locations in San Jose and San Francisco, respectively. For 10 points, name these large shopping centers.
