

- 1) **This location's downtown contained Dill's General Store and Katz's Kandy and that downtown was destroyed by one of the two Teddy Bears.** This location was once shown on a map as in the middle of Kansas in an episode where di Lung crashed a satellite into near a house in this city. A 2021 Scooby Doo film was titled for this location, as it served as a crossover with Muriel and the most famous dog who lives here and constantly fights Le Quack and Cajun Fo. For 10 points, name this home "town" of Courage the Cowardly Dog.

ANSWER: **Nowhere**

- 2) **This character is told to "tell that fuckin' bitch to chill" by a character who asks him if he reads the Bible.** This character has a pack of Red Apple cigarettes in the opening scene of a certain movie and in a deleted scene, this is the first person Jules daydreams about killing, by firing up through a table twice. In the final scene of a movie, this character holds a gun up to a cafe owner who shouts "please, I'm just a coffee shop" and he commits a robbery with Honey Bunny. For 10 points, name this character from *Pulp Fiction*, played by Tim Roth.

ANSWER: **Pumpkin** [or **Ringo**]

- 3) **Before 1857, baseball games didn't last a fixed number of innings, but until one team scored this many runs.** In the 2011 National Championship game, Alabama beat LSU with this many points, in a shutout. Phil Housley and Cal Ricken played this many seasons and Stan Mikita wore this jersey number. Baker Mayfield threw this number of interceptions in 2019. A basketball game that can be played one-on-one is traditionally titled for this number, the amount required to win, and the next Madden game will be titled for this number. For ten points, name this ideal number of points in a game of blackjack.

ANSWER: **21**

- 4) **In The Long Halloween, this character is spared for death on April Fool's Day by Holiday, and he's later a member of Two-Face's jury in the Hangman trials.** This character, after using Ra's al Ghul's Lazarus Pit to cure his own terminal brain cancer, teams up with Hush to set loose a major part of Batman's Rogues gallery. This character is likely known as Kwiz Kid in *Teen Titans Go* and in his first appearance is presumed drowned except for a floating question mark in the water. For 10 points, what type of "E Nigma" resists solving but will kill you if you don't?

ANSWER: The **Riddler**

- 5) **Object and phrase required.**

One of these objects said this two-word phrase to Father Delaney to compel him to stop helping the Lutz family. One of these objects says this phrase in the terrible 2019 Addams Family animated movie, prompting Morticia to give this object its morning coffee. In the first Simpsons Treehouse of Horror sketch, one of these objects says this two-word phrase while Bart and Lisa argue about whether Bart threw a book at Lisa and Homer attributed it to a building settling. For 10 points, name this action, usually a parody of The Amityville Horror, when a private domicile tells people to leave.
ANSWER: **House** saying **Get Out**

- 6) **This number titles the debut album of Dutch trance DJ Armin van Buuren. P.K. Subban of the Nashville Predators wears this sweater number. A chain of gas stations named for this number employs a logo consisting of an orange circle and blue text.** The Syracuse Nationals was the original name of a Big Four team partly named for this number. For ten points, identify this number that describes the amount of trombones that “led the big parade” in The Music Man.

ANSWER: **76** <Mickey Sizemore Tossup>

- 7) **Most priests in this religion do not have a permanent home, and go barefoot, usually relying on gifts from local farmers. This religion has no temples, books, or idols, and its priests will not bathe in any water except the ocean.** Women are not allowed to sit in this religion’s Seastone Chair and this religion’s chief deity opposes the Storm God. For 10 points, name this religion practiced by the Ironborn in *Game of Thrones*, whose litany includes the line “Lord God who drowned for us,”

ANSWER: The **Cult of the Drowned God** (Or the religion on the Iron Islands. Take “The religion of the Ironborn” before that phrase comes up in the tossup)

- 8) **Even though this movie was its director’s first full-length film, that director had already won a directing Oscar for the short-length movie Bao.** A pair of statues outside a temple, in this movie, are named Bart and Lisa as an homage to the **Simpsons**. The band 4*Town in this movie had all their music written by Billie Eilish and Mei and Abby secretly raise money for tickets by exploiting the central curse. For 10 points, name this 2022 Pixar movie about a girl who turns into a giant red panda when emotional.

ANSWER: **Turning Red**

- 9) **These two teams played the 1980 “Announcerless game” and the Vikings’ head coach Kevin O’Connell spent 2011 on these two teams.** One of these two teams beat the other in the 1982 AFC Championship game, in the “Mud Bowl,” their lone playoff meeting; and Vinny Testaverde came back down 30-7 to help one team claim the AFC East over the other. These two teams played in a legendary “Fake Spike” game

when Dan Marino found Mark Ingram in the endzone, and in 2021 they played a pair of games where Tua Tagovailoa looked better than Zach Wilson. For 10 points, name these rivals who play in East Rutherford and Miami.

ANSWER: **Dolphins** [or **Miami**] and **Jets** [prompt on “New York”]

10) **These things are “White” in a 2007 documentary in which singer Kylie Minogue discusses her battle with breast cancer.** These things are “Liquid” in a song by Tori Amos, and the opening track of Lady Gaga’s album *Joanne* is titled for a heart of this material. These minerals are the only material on the Mohs Hardness Scale to appear on the album *Graceland*. For ten points, identify these valuable items that are paired with “Pearls” in a Prince song, and that partly title the stage name of Marina Diamandis.

ANSWER: **Diamonds** <Mickey Sizemore Tossup>

11) **A member of this profession, Doug Henning, performed the Sands of the Nile, which requires use of sodium metabisulfite.** Members of this profession may use a topit to discreetly dispose of items, and they may also make use of a thumb tip or funkenring; and most members of this profession know the french drop, or "Le Tourniquet," which involves palming. Members of this profession may use a Svengali Deck, which is useful in performing the Ambitious Card, and supposedly, a good member of this profession never reveals his secrets. For ten points, name this profession whose novices may mime sawing a woman in half while saying “abracadabra.”

ANSWER: Stage **Magician**

12) **This object was placed, with Pidgeot, into the PC, though it was later retrieved, causing Eevee to be considered a false prophet.** This is one of the objects that can be obtained in *HeartGold* by breaking rocks at the Ruins of Alph, though it is no longer a key object in that game, and this is the second object, alphabetically, that the player can take from a Super Nerd after defeating them at Mt. Moon. This object became the center of a folk religion during a famous meme-inspiring playthrough on Twitch and can be regenerated into an Omanyte. For 10 points, name this object that’s contrasted with the Dome Fossil, named for its spiral shape.

ANSWER: Helix Fossil (**praise Helix**)

13) **An active player of this position developed the “Watermelon” type of that a certain play.** In 1972, a player at this position failed in two different plays in the Auburn vs. Alabama game, allowing 14-point underdog Auburn to win, in a game commonly referred to by an action players from this position take. It’s not rugby related, but players from this position specialize in spiral and end-over-end types of a certain action. According to ProFootballReference, Shane Lechler was the best ever athlete at this

position, though Ray Guy is the only Hall of Famer. For 10 points, name this position whose players expertly give the ball away to the other team.

ANSWER: Punter

14) **In Batman: The Brave and the Bold, Lois Lane and Jimmy Olsen lead an angry mob that takes this action when Superman declared himself king. In Gravity Falls, Gideon “accidentally” takes this action when Stan is locked in stockades and Ron wonders where the central items come from when campers at Camp Wannawep do this when he’s on stage.** This action happens to Larry the Cucumber when he’s yodeling, over furious protestations by Bob. For 10 points, name this fruit-pelting action that usually targets bad performers.

ANSWER: Throwing Tomatoes at Someone [or, you know, personal judgment if it sounds close]

15) **One movie with this name sees the central character claim “dogs have fleas; managers have sports writers” before getting hit in the head with a line drive and agreeing to marry Janet Leigh.** In that movie, Guffy McGovern is promised help from the Heavenly Choir Nine, but only if he stops swearing or fighting. Another movie with this title saw a boy, played by a young Joseph Gordon-Levitt, pray that a California baseball team win the pennant, and then be able to see the divine beings making it happen. For 10 points, name this pair of movies whose title implies divine beings just outside the infield.

ANSWER: Angels in the Outfield

16) **In 1996, this pitcher led the American League in losses with 18, with a 7.48 E.R.A., causing him to retire for a year before he joined the White Sox in 1998.** This 1987 Golden Spikes award winner pitched the final game for the U.S. in the 1988 Olympics, helping result in admission to the College Baseball Hall of Fame, and In 1993, this pitcher threw a well-publicized no-hitter for the Yankees, after the Angels traded him for J.T. Snow and Russ Springer. Teams would try to exploit this pitcher by bunting at him, and he largely played in the A.L. because of batting difficulties. For 10 points, name this 90’s one-handed pitcher.

ANSWER: Jim Abbott

17) **A primary line in this story arc starts collapsing as a little girl named Laila remembers what happened before Wanda intervened.** Luke Cage leads the Human Resistance Movement in this story arc that sees Carol Danvers as the world’s most popular hero and Dr. Strange as a random psychiatrist. Wolverine is the only major hero in this story arc with memories of before the switch, knowing that everyone seems to have

their primary wish in life granted. For 10 points, name this pivotal Marvel story arc in which an unstable Scarlet Witch makes mutants the dominant species on earth.

ANSWER: House of M

- 18) In Gravity Falls, Bill Cipher sings this song to symbolize that it's the end of the world, and in the final episode of the Colbert Report, Colbert and his family sang this song with many of his guests. This song, one of the ones covered on Johnny Cash's "American IV," played in the first trailer to Season 3 of Westworld and this song plays in the credits of Far Cry V if you get the nuclear ending. Pink Floyd referenced this song in The Wall in the song "Vera," a reference to its original singer Vera Lynn. For 10 points, name this song that plays during the nuclear holocaust in Dr. Strangelove, that promises the title action will happen even if the singer "don't know how/don't know when."

ANSWER: "We'll Meet Again"

- 19) In American History X, Lamont claims to be the most dangerous person in the prison because he controls this action. In Everything Everywhere All at Once, Waymond claims that in another life he "would enjoy doing" this activity "and taxes with you," and someone who owns a business where people can do this activity wrote off a karaoke machine as a business expense. In Wayne's World, Garth talks to a pretty girl and eats liquorice rope in a scene where he destroys clothes by failing at this action. For 10 points, name this action that Michael Oher takes in The Blind Side on a woman's leftover time on a washer and dryer.

ANSWER: Doing Laundry [as always, take anything like "washing clothes" or anything common sense]

- 20) One of these two athletes claimed, angrily, that "pettiness didn't cost us" after failing to get past the first round of the playoffs and once these two athletes combined for three alley-oops in 35 seconds. One of these two athletes said "You don't know what you've got til its gone," referring to missing the other, on "All the Smoke " and Charles Barkley rified about their size difference after a locker room confrontation required police presence. This tandem of athletes were the general backbone to the Clippers' "Lob City" teams. For 10 points, name this big man with the Nets and point guard for the Suns, with a combined four first names.

ANSWER: Blake Griffin and Chris Paul [accept CP3 for Chris Paul. Also, no one's ever seen Black Griffin in the same room as Spider-man.]

- 21) This instrument sounds closer to a bansuri flute than to its most commonly related instrument and it is related to the visi-sonor, and Harrison Krix created a version of this instrument with 54 LED lights by modifying a "Vito." Jonathan Wienel et al

wrote a paper claiming that this instrument is the “ideal visual music instrument,” and described the challenges of making it both portable and expressive. This double-reeded instrument has a clarinet fingering system, according to fan reconstructions of this instrument that “only a few people can play– and none of them play it well.” For 10 points, name this cross between an oboe and a holographic projector, played by a few people in the 31st century.

ANSWER: Holophonor

22) In Mario Kart Tour, this substance appears as a motif on the banners on the level *Ninja Hideaway* and the dojo windows are shaped like this substance. In the minigame “Flee the Flashlight,” the primary point is to steal this substance without getting caught, and in *Mario Tennis Aces*, one character eats this substance to charge up a special shot, named the “Glorious *this substance* Bomber.” This substance can be purchased from dispensers for coins and restores life to Wario in *Wario World* and eating the “nasty” type turns Wario into Wario-Man in *WarioWare: Touched*. For 10 points, name this foodstuff that supposedly gives Wario his stamina, bad breath, and immunity to vampires.

ANSWER: Garlic
