1. *Note to players: two answers required. Moderator: read the answer line carefully.*

**These two people were the targets of Operation Perfect Alliance, which released the pacifying Alliance mobile app. The Order of the Guardians were restored after these two people vanquished Feast, an ancient sentimonster. The powers of these two people are granted by Tikki and Plagg, the most powerful of the kwamis, representing the concepts of destruction and creation. Master (\*) Fu** tasked these two people with addressing the threat of akumatization, the process by which a negative emotion triggers the creation of super-villains. One of these people possesses the Cataclysm power and wields a staff, while the other can create Lucky Charms and wields a yo-yo. For 10 points, name these two Parisian teens who transform into superheroes using their Miraculous.

2. *Note to players: specific term required.*

**This substance was extracted by a machine shaped like a ram's skull, after which it was used on people who had "fallen down," such as Lemon Bread. Experimental vessels for this substance included the seeds of Golden Flowers, and those experiments created entities called Memoryheads as well as the Reaper Bird. This substance was accidentally used to revive (\*) Asriel Dreemurr's** consciousness, but not his soul, turning him into a cruel talking flower. Alphys found that this substance, which differentiates humans' SOULs from monsters', caused monsters to melt into pale white Amalgamates. For 10 points, name this substance that gave the six human SOULs the ability to persist after death, and which Frisk feels fill their body every time they SAVE.

3. **The Wand of Dianthus, bestowed with magic from a unicorn, was the reward for a series of missions centered on this structure. Solving four riddles based on ancient stories by utilizing this structure is the test for one to become a Master Librarian. A moonstone, a mango, and a mammoth bone flute are among the artifacts brought to this structure to reverse the curse placed on the transformed (\*) mouse Peanut. This structure was destroyed by the Galveston hurricane before reappearing fully repaired in its primary location in Frog Creek, Pennsylvania. Due to their passion for knowledge and fantasy, this structure is visible to siblings who are mentored by this structure's original owner, Morgan La Fay. For 10 points, name this structure that the children Jack and Annie Smith use to travel across time and space.**

4. **Mammalian studies on this contagion scored mental and physical effects with the Schuler-Kapp index. The eponymous Curling-13 variant of this contagion had maximum lethality with minimum exposure. The EEP strain of this contagion had a 100% rate of sterilization. Dr. Weston Lesko's research on this contagion's effects on ants resulted in the ants undergoing a process he dubbed "pyrosis." In addition to the Scorched Plague, the (\*) Huntersville strain of this contagion spread throughout Appalachia. The Brotherhood of Steel's aversion to new technology primarily stems from the development of this contagion as part of the Pan-Immunity Virion run by West Tek. For 10 points, name this virus that mutated many VaultTec Vault survivors.**

5. **Jennifer Stavros has the ability to control this phenomenon by generating red or black discs. The North Korean Dr. Tramma set up a "body shop" in New York City that used cybernetic enhancements to restore a crime boss's power over this phenomenon. It's not weather related, but after training up a cognitive control of this phenomenon, Neena Thurman was able to generate lightning strikes. When his intentions are pure, the four-fingered slave of (\*) Mojoworld named Longshot has a subconscious positive influence over this phenomenon. Cable chose a mercenary woman with mutant control of this phenomenon to help co-lead the X-Force. That mercenary's name is Domino. For 10 points, name this phenomenon that Black Cat can aptly turn "bad."**  
ANS: **luck** [accept **probability** fields and equivalents to **chance**]

6. **This magic user drew a pentagram and lit toad-fat candles in a rite to summon the biggest bird in the world. This magic user plotted with the witch Chlorhydris (clor-HIGH-driss) to steal Santa's magic but was foiled by Scruple, (SCROO-pull), his own apprentice in the dark arts. On the final night of a full moon, this magic user's Great Book of Spells awakens and grants them the instructions for one powerful ritual. This magic user's hunt for ingredients for the (\*) Philosopher's Stone was assisted by his cat Azrael. A succubus creature created by this spellcaster was later turned into a full being by the magic of Papa's True Blue Spell. For 10 points, name this warlock who is the sworn enemy of the Smurfs.**  
ANS: **Gargamel**
7. **The indestructible Harlequin Chest was made to hide a collection of these items. During the Revolutionary War, minutemen hiding in the Drowning Cave stumbled upon Whispering Iron, which was used to make these items. A child fashioned a weapon by taping one of these objects to the end of his toy lightsaber to incapacitate a demon wielding the Crown of Shadows. That one of these items resembled a matchstick. Using the Head one of these items on the back of someone's head allows one to enter their mind, which was used by the demon (\*) Dodge to find the Omega one of these items. The Anywhere one of these items, which can transport the user to any place they have seen a door, was the first of these small objects found in a manor named for them. For 10 points, name these household objects that are aptly discovered by the Locke family.**

8. **In the World of the Coinless timeline, the power ranger of this color piloted the chimeric Gravezord and became known as the Ranger Slayer. Zordon explained “too much [of this color] is dangerous” when this color ranger tried to recruit a 2nd one after being sent back to the Wild West. While wearing this color for the SPD team, Syd Drew always carried an iron nugget, which they used to turn their fists into iron. It’s not red, but this color was the leader on the (\*) Time Force team. Kat Hillard inherited this color and its Crane Ninjazord after its holder retired to pursue gymnastics. On the Mighty Morphin’ Team, the ranger of this color wielded the Power Bow and harnessed the power of the Pterodactyl. For 10 points, name this color donned by Kimberly Ann Hart.**

9. **During one of these conflicts, the city of **Golyn Niis (GOAL-in NEESE)** was the site of many “relaxation houses” where invaders tortured citizens. The Non-Aggression Pact that ended the 2nd of these conflicts was reached thanks to Hesperian intervention. According to legend, the Warrior, the Gatekeeper, and the Vipress formed the Trifecta, which unified a side and won one of these conflicts. During one of these conflicts, the Ram Warlord commanded forces at the Battle of **Sinegard (SIN-e-gard)**. In the aftermath of one of these conflicts, Empress Su Daji’s reign was threatened by the (\*) Dragon Republic. After the Speerly genocide committed during one of these conflicts, one survivor, Rin, decisively ended the third of these conflicts by using shamanism to channel the Phoenix God. For 10 points, name these conflicts named after an addictive plant.**

10. **Crepus, the head confessor, could inflict this condition with the bolts of his Black-Key Crossbow. Dewkissed Herba is one of the few ingredients in making Preserving **Boluses (BOWL-usses)** that can abate this condition. Named after an afflicted White Dragon, the incantation Enzykes’s Decay can inflict this condition. The legendary Blind Swordsman sealed away the source of this condition underneath the region of the Ainsel River. One of the few ways to forestall the spread of this condition is with the Unalloyed Gold (\*) Needle, which was repaired by the Sage Gowry. The spread of this condition began after a flower bloomed inside the Blade of Miquella. For 10 points, name this colorful fungal affliction that Malenia spread throughout the Lands Between.**  
ANS: **scarlet rot** [prompt on rot]

11. **One of these objects named Drain Fafnir is a powerful implementation of their God Layer System design. Dr. Zagart’s failed research attempted to bond Orthos and Cerberus to some of these objects. According to its inheritor Boris Balkov, one of these objects named Black Dranzer was cursed by the darkness in the soul of its creator, the Russian monk Rasputin. (\*) Tyson Granger wielded one of these objects possessed by Dragoon, one of the sacred spirits known as Bit Beasts. According to Doji, one of these objects, L-Drago, was used by Moses to part the Red Sea. In the competition centering on these objects, they are launched into a stadium by quickly pulling on a ripcord. For 10 points, name these powerful spinning tops.**

12. A temple for this deity houses “dreaming couches” where visitors can use candles to see visions. In that temple, a “gift” from this deity can be received by drinking from a large pool of black water with a stone cup. A cult for this deity claims this deity appears to non-believers in other forms such as the Weeping Lady or the Lion of Night. The common response to (\*) “valar morghulis,” a phrase said by people worshiping this deity, is “valar dohaeris,” or “all men must serve.” The House of Black and White, named for the colors of its doors, is the center of worship for this deity. That temple is found in the Free City of Bravos and is run by a cult of shapeshifting assassins. For 10 points, name this deity, to whom Arya Stark was taught to say “not today.”

ANS: The Many-Faced God [accept Him of Many Face or The God of Death]

13. The Q-series of these machines made both the W and P series obsolete with its improved defenses. A first generation one of these machines named Delnik was reprogrammed into a probability machine by Doctor Aphra. A group paid for the construction of these machines by feeding exotic meat to the engineers on the planet Colla IV. These machines, also called “destroyers,” were designed by the engineers of the Colicoid Creation Nest in their own image. The repeating (\*) blasters on these machines served useful in blowing up shield generators during the Battle of Naboo. These machines are most vulnerable from behind and while moving because their defense relies on their hemispherical deflector shield generator. For 10 points, name these deadly machines given the nickname “rollies” by enemy Clone Troopers.

ANS: droidekas [accept destroyer droids before mention; accept rollies before mention; prompt on droids; reject “battle droids”]

14. The tyrannical Gair XVII (the seventeenth) was defeated when this goddess recruited eleven other deities to assist in the Miracle of Dahna. This goddess’s daughter was heralded as her “Voice” and guarded the Azure in the Mila Tree. This goddess sealed feral dragons in the Dragon’s Table using an item this goddess forged that was embedded with five spheres. This goddess granted Heim her (\*) Book, the most powerful weapon against the evil earth dragon Loptous. (LOP-tuss). This mother of Tiki turned her fangs into the Binding Shield and the Falchion, which were given to humans in order to protect them from attacking dragons. For 10 points, name this goddess, whose blessings empowered heroes like Lucina, Chrom, and Marth.

15. This king blew the Horn of Cathbhadh (CATH-vath) to receive guidance from the spirit of his predecessor. Queen Annis declared war against this king after he executed her husband King Caerleon (cur-LEE-un) for raiding his territory. On a quest to prove his worthiness as king, this man was unwittingly given a bracelet of Phoenix feather that sapped his life energy. The last remaining dragon after the Great Purge, Kligharrah, foretold this ruler’s destiny. A priestess of the Old Religion, (\*) Nimueh, used the Powers over Life and Death to bring about the birth of this ruler by taking the life of his mother Ygraine, (ee-GRAIN), resulting in this king’s father banning all forms of magic. After being wounded at the battle of Camlann, this king and his sword were laid at rest in Lake Avalon. For 10 points, name this king, advised by his warlock companion Merlin.

ANS: King Arthur Pendragon of Camelot [prompt on just “Pendragon”]

**A publication of this text opens with a passage from the W.B Yeats essay “The Celtic Twilight.” A riddle poem that read “In a man’s torso you will find / My secret to all mankind” led to this text’s discovery via a dumbwaiter. According to this text, eating a blackberry after the 1st of November will anger a **phooka**. (POO-ka). In 2005, the authors Tony DiTerlizzi and Holly Black published a “accurately restored and described” version of this book with a (\*) Simon & Schuster arm for young readers. This book’s claim that fresh cow milk accelerates the growth of dragons was used by the ogre Mulgarath to raise a dragon army. According to this text, a stone with a natural hole provides the Sight, the ability to see the Invisible World. For 10 points, name this educational book discovered by the Grace family in its author’s Victorian estate.**

ANS: *Arthur **Spiderwick's Field Guide** to the Fantastical World Around You* [accept anything indicating the “guide by/from **Spiderwick**”]

17. **A leader of this group had a brief stint living in the closet of Adam, a horror movie producer, as his “imaginary friend,” where he gave him advice on dating Corri. This group raised a T-Rex who frequently dies and comes back to life named Gor-Gor. This group was taught in their current vocation by Sleazy P. Martini. Cardinal Syn nearly defeated this group after eating the baby birthed by Slymenstra (sli-MEN-stra) Hymen after this group’s first leader, Oderus Urungus, impregnated her with the (\*) Cuttlefish of Cthulhu. This group was sent to Earth after proving too incompetent to be Scumdogs of the Universe. The Berserker Blóthar took over this group, whose other members include Beefcake the Mighty, JiZMac da Gusha, and BälSác the Jaws ‘o Death, who play bass, drums, and guitar, respectively. For 10 points, name this heavy metal band whose members are alien vikings.**

Young residents called Dibbuns enjoy the staple of strawberry cordial during this location’s festival of Nameday, a holiday that celebrates the naming of the season. The vegetarian cuisine of this location gets many of its ingredients from the nearby woods of Mossflower. For 10 points, name this abbey whose cellar keepers are hedgehogs and moles, and whose monks include a mouse named Matthias.**

The Barrier Mountains separate a land named after this object from a country formerly known as Pirra. Shortly after its creation, this object was used to win a battle against an army of Greer led by the commanders Trel and Sheela. One component of this object that changes color in the presence of evil was held sacred by the (\*) Dread Gnomes. Four of the seven Ak-Baba were killed in a battle against the seven dragons of a land named after this object. The blacksmith Adin forged this object, whose parts were collected by a group that included a girl who could talk to trees, Jasmine. That group found the Topaz, one of seven components of this object, in the Forest of Silence. For 10 points, the Shadow Lord was defeated after Lief reassembled the seven gems of what belt?**

By casting the soul-draining blood sigil, a member of this family time traveled to meet his grandchildren in order to escape from the Knight of Hell Abaddon. (a-BAD-in). Cain and Abel are the originators of this bloodline, whose descendants can be used as a vessel by the (\*) Archangel Michael. Members of this family killed the vampire nest of Luther to obtain the Colt, a gun that could kill anything shot with its original 13 bullets. Mary Campbell married into this family and her death spurred this family's vengeance against the yellow-eyed demon Azazel. The father of this family, John, passed down his 1967 Chevrolet Impala as an heirloom. For 10 points, name this family of supernatural hunters including Sam and Dean.**
