Arthur Kornberg.
One of the biggest controversies in the late nineteenth century was over currency. "Soft money" advocates insisted on the coinage of silver with a value ratio to gold of 16 to 1 , while "sound money" advocates rejected any coinage of silver at all. A pseudo-compromise was struck in 1878 with an act that required the Treasury to coin between 2 and 4 million dollars in silver per month. FTP, name this act.

## Bland-AllisonAct of 1878
