5. HENRI, DAVIES, AND HOPPER CONTRIBUTED TO THIS ARTISTIC SCHOOL. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS MOVEMENT LASTING FROM 1908-1918 THAT DEPICTED SCENES OF URBAN REALISM.
