- 1. Encouraged by his dedicated political mentor, Louis McHenry Howe, he resumed his career by nominating Alfred E. Smith for the presidency at the Democratic convention in 1924 and again in 1928, when Smith won the party's nomination. Anxious to win the New York State electoral vote, Smith persuaded him to campaign for the governorship, given the latter's strong upstate appeal. Deeply in debt and disabled by polio, he won a narrow victory.
- 2. Charles I and Prince Rupert led the losing Royalists against Cromwell and Sir Thomas Fairfax. It was the first major success of the New Model Army. FTP name this battle which brought the first stage of the Civil War to a close on June 14, 1645. \Naseby(June 14, 1645)\
- 3. After the war he became a member of the Republican party. From 1880 to 1881 he was U.S. minister to Turkey, and from 1897 until his death in Gainesville, Georgia, on January 2, 1904, he held the position of federal commissioner of Pacific railroads. At the Second Battle of Bull Run, the Confederate victory was due largely to his timely arrival and effective tactics. His further participation in the battles of Antietam and Fredericksburg (both in 1862) won him promotion to lieutenant general. FTP name this South-Carolinian born Confederate general.

 Vames Longstreet(1821-1904)\
- 4. B in 1860, in 1891, he made the first of many tours of the US. Minuet in G is one of his popular piano pieces. B in Podolia, he was educated at the Warsaw Conservatory. FTP name this 1st Polish Foreign Minister and Prime Minister.
- 5. Retaining their seats after Pride's purge, they were the members of the Long Parliament who declared the Commonwealth of England. Increasingly corrupt and ineffective, they refused dissolution until Cromwell's soldires ejected it on April 20, 1653 replacing it with the Barebones parliament. FTP name this parliament which was reconvened in 1659. \Rump (parliament)\
- 6. He wrote Calculated Risk and From the Danube to the Yalu. Between 1942 and 1945 he served in WWII as chief of staff of the U.S. Army ground forces, as deputy commander in chief of the Allied forces invading North Africa, and as commander of the U.S. Fifth Army during the invasion of Italy(led landing at Salerno, just S of Naples). He was U.S. high commissioner for Austria from 1945 until 1947. Returning to the U.S., he commanded the Sixth Army from 1947 until 1949 and was chief of the army field forces from 1949 until 1952. He was supreme commander of the United Nations forces in the Korean War during 1952 and 1953. Clark was president of the Citadel from 1954 until 1966.

- 7. He was crowned at Scone by the Scots(1649) after the execution of his father. FTP who lost in 1651 at Worcester to Oliver Cromwell? \Charles II(reign:1660-1685)\
- 8. Educated at the U.S. Military Academy, he graduated second in his class in 1829, receiving a commission as second lieutenant in the engineers. He distinguished himself in the battles of the Mexican War and was wounded in the storming of Chapultepec in 1847. He became superintendent of the U.S. Military Academy and later was appointed colonel of cavalry. He was in command of the Department of Texas in 1860, and, early the following year, was summoned to Washington, D.C., when war between the states seemed imminent. President Abraham Lincoln offered him the field command of the Union forces, but he declined. \Robert E. Lee\
- 9. Called by the Germans "Dietrich", he led the Ostrogoths into Italy and beat Odoacer in 2 battles. In 493, he had Odoacer killed. FTP name this Ostrogoth. \Theodoric\
- 10. He wrote two books in which he explained his program: Every Man a King (1933) and My First Days in the White House (1935). He was educated at the University of Oklahoma and Tulane University and then became railroad commissioner. On September 10, 1935, he was assassinated by the son-in-law of a political opponent. \Huey Pierce Long(1893-1935)\
- 1. It was incorporated by Royal Charter in 1600. After the massacre of Amboina, it established itself in Bengal. FTP name this company intended to take advantage of the decline in Portugal's commercial power in the Far East, which survived until 1873. \East India Company\

- 12. He wrote The Growth of Children (1896), The Mind of Primitive Man (1911), Anthropology and Modern Life (1928), and Race, Language, and Culture (1940). \Franz Boas\
- 13. He was head of the post-WWI reparations commission. Co-winner of the 1925 Nobel Peace Prize, he was VP from under Coolidge from 1925-1929. FTP name this author of a 1924 plan. \Charles Gates Dawes(1865-1951)\
- 14. The battle of Preston(1648) was the first battle in which he held independent command. He left his son in law Henry Ireton to eliminate dissidents from the Long Parliament in Pride's purge and to establish a court to try the K. He ordered the massacres of civilians at Drogheda and Wexford. FTP who turned down the kingship in the Humble Petition and Advice of 1657, but was still the most powerful man in England then.
 \Oliver Cromwell\
- 15. After the Civil War, he was for some time chief engineer for the state of Alabama. He replaced General Pierre Gustave Toutant Beauregard as commander of the Army of the Tennessee in June 1862. Invading Kentucky in August 1862, he nearly succeeded in taking Louisville but was compelled to withdraw into Tennessee. At the Battle of Murfreesboro, or Stones River, he fought Union forces under General William Starke Rosecrans to a draw, but then withdrew his army. In September 1863, however, he inflicted a decisive defeat on Rosecrans in the Battle of Chickamauga. Soon afterward he was defeated by General Ulysses S. Grant in the three-day Battle of Chattanooga. FTP name this North Carolinian born Confederate.

 \Braxton Bragg(1817-1876)\
- 16. FAQTP name the son of James II known as the Old Pretender. \Charles Edward Stuart\
- 17. He was the pupil and brother-in-law of Francisco Bayeu. Influenced by Anton Mengs, he grew deaf in his 40's and started painting his preoccupation with the morbid, bizarre, and the menacing such as in his Black Paintings. FTP name this painter of The Third of May 1808.

It is the name of 2 battles. One was a 1455 battle that followed the conclusion of the protectorate of Richard, duke of York. King Henry Vi was wounded at the Yorkist victory. Another was a 1461 battle in which Margaret of Anjou led the Lancastrians over the forces of Warwick the kingmaker. They rescued Henry VI but were unable to prevent the accession of Edward IV 10 days later. \Battle of St. Albans\

In what 1460 battle was Richard, duke of York killed at?

\Battle of Wakefield\

In what 1461 battle was Owen Tudor captured and beheaded, after which Edward IV marched to London and was proclaimed King of England.

\Battle of Mortimer's Cross\

For the final 5 points name either Edward IV's wife, or his brother who objected to his marriage, or his most powerful supporter for a while. The brother of Edward IV and the supporter, nicknamed "the kingmaker" briefly restored Henry VI to the throne in 1470. \Elizabeth Woodville - George, duke of Clarence - Warwick, the kingmaker or Richard Neville, earl of Warwick and Salisbury\

19. The last major presidential candidate for a major party to sport a beard, it seemed that he had offended Hiram Johnson, the governor of CA and Johnson did not get the full Republican vote out for him in CA so he lost by only 23 electoral votes to Wilson in 1916.

20. It was an assembly of 140 "godly men" chosen by Oliver Cromwell and the Council of Officers. The dissolution of it heralded the Instrument of Gov't and the Proclamation of O. Cromwell as Lord Protector. It was also called the Nominated Parliament. FTP name this Parliament from July-Dec of 1653 nicknamed after Praisegod Barbon.

\Barebones parliament(July-December 1653)\
