- 1. It served as the first capital of Italy. IT was the birthplace of Victor Emmanuel II. Lying at the confluence of the Po and the Dora Riparia rivers, it is the capital of the Piedmont region. FTP name this city the birthplace of Cavour, Avogadro, and Lagrange. \Turin, Ita\
- 2. In his metaphysics, he argued for the existence of a divine being, described as the Prime Mover, who is responsible for the unity and purposefulness of nature. His works include First Philosophy, the treatise On the Soul, his Rhetoric, his Poetics (which survives in incomplete form), and his Politics (also incomplete). FTP who established the Lyceum?

- 3. The Native Americans of the Northwest Territories, fearing its takeover by the Canadians penetrated as far south as what is now Winnipeg but were quickly dispersed. FTP name this 1869 rebellion led by Louis Riel. \Red River Rebellion\
- 4. He was black and his achievements were unusual in his day. B in 1835, he composed such works as "Carry me Back to Old Virginny" and "Oh, Dem Golden Slippers". FTP name this composer of "In the Evening by the Moonlight". \Undersample \text{James A. Bland(1835-1899)}\
- 5. On November 15, he landed, at the head of an army, at Torbay and marched virtually unopposed to London. Resistance to him was shown at the battle of Killiecrankie. FTP who married the daughter of James II, Mary. \William III(reign: 1689-1702)\
- 6. She appeared in "Bonjour Tristesse", "Paint Your Wagon", and "Airport". She was plucked from Iowa after a much-publicized talent hunt to find a teenage unknown to star in a movie about Joan of Arc by Otto Preminger, called "Saint Joan". Apparently, she took her own life after being hounded by J. Edgar Hoover's FBI for her involvement with the Black Panthers in the '60s. At 21, she was cast opposite Jean-Paul Belmondo in "Breathless". FTP who married the French writer Romain Gary? Vean Seberg
- 7. An army of samurai, the old knightly class, objecting to the formation of an army of commoners, marched against the gov't including the governor Mutsohito. The samurai were defeated by the commoners, trained in modern fashion, and feudal Japan was forever gone. FTP name this 1877 rebellion.

- 8. Some tales depict him as pitiless and cruel. According to Homer's Illiad, he answered the prayers of the priest Chryses to obtain the release of his daughter from the Greek general Agamemnon by shooting fiery, pestilence-carrying arrows into the Greek army. FTP name this player of the lyre.

- 9. In 414 he went with the Spartan expedition to the island of Khjos, where he incited an Ionian revolt against the Athenians. Difficulties with the Spartan leaders led to a plot to assassinate him. On learning of the plot, he fled to the Persian provincial governor Tissaphernes and attempted without success to win him over to the Athenians on the ground that it was in the interest of Persia to prevent Sparta from gaining complete ascendancy over Athens. He then offered to bring Persian support to the Athenians if they would revoke the decree making him an exile. His offer was accepted, but he wished to render some service to Athens before returning. He therefore won important victories for the Athenians, including the capture of the cities of Cyzicus, Chalcedon, and Byzantium. FTP who returned to Athens in 407 and was received with general enthusiasm?
- 10. It was the name popularly applied to Northern members of the Democratic party, also known as Peace Democrats, who opposed the administration of Abraham Lincoln and advocated compromise with the Confederate states to end the war. FTP the leading member of what group was the Ohio Congressman of slave-state descent, Clement Laird Vallandigham(1820-1871)? \Copperheads\
- 11. The February Rev. of 1848 caused Frederick William IV of Prussia to concede to German liberals while upseting the Austrian conservatives. On Nov. 19, 1849, Prussia gave up any thought of heading any sort of union, although Fred. William IV had been offered the crown at a meeting in this city in Moravia. FTP what was later referred to by Prussian historians as "the humiliation of THIS"?
- 12. FAQTP name the winner and losers of the 1879-1884, War of the Pacific.

- 13. His most important writings are Cyropaedia, an idealized biography of Cyrus the Great; Hellenica, a continuation, covering the period 411 to 363 BC of Thucydides' History of the Peloponnesian War; and Memorabilia, recollections of Socrates and Socratic conversations. He also wrote an encomium of Agesilaus; a group of political and economic treatises; a series of essays on horsemanship, hunting, and cavalry warfare; and several additional Socratic dialogues. FTP name this soldier, orator, philosopher, essayist, and historian, a student of Socrates. \Xenophon\
- 14. He served in the army from 1862 to 1867. During this time he conducted two successive exploratory expeditions in Siberia and Manchuria, which resulted in valuable geographic information. In 1867 he returned to Saint Petersburg, where he was appointed an official of the Russian Geographic Society. On behalf of the society he explored the glaciers of Finland and Sweden between 1871 and 1873. While thus engaged, Kropotkin also studied the writings of the leading political theorists and eventually adopted socialist revolutionary views. FTP name this Russian geographer, who was the foremost theorist of the anarchist movement. \Prince Pyotr Alekseyevich Kropotkin(1842-1921)\
- 15. Among his critical writings are Reflections of a Nonpolitical Man (1918), an autobiographical essay in which he concluded that an artist must be involved with society. His own involvement resulted in the loss of his German citizenship in 1936; this occurred after he had received the 1929 Nobel Prize in literature, principally for his novel Buddenbrooks. \Thomas Mann\
- 16. It was formed in 1686 by Aut, SWE, Spain, Bavaria, Saxony, and the Palatinate. FTP name this ineffective alliance formed against Louis XIV for which a War got its name. \League of Augsburg(1686 SWE)\
- 17. B in 1860, he worked in the Census Bureau and developed a method in the 1880s for tabulating and sorting data with unprecedented speed by making use of punched cards and electric currents. FTP name this founder of IBM. \Herman Hollerith(1860-1929)\
- 18. He sent Stanley to find Livingstone. FTP name this man, the first to sell newspapers for a mere cent apiece. \James Gordon Bennett(1795-1872)\
- 19. His murder, one of the most sensational in the annals of U.S. society, resulted from the discovery by Pittsburgh millionaire, Harry Kendall Thaw that his wife, the actor Evelyn Nesbit, had been involved in a love affair with him. FTP what architect was shot in and killed on the roof of NYC's Madison Square Garden in 1906? \Stanford White(1853-1906)\
- 20. The most notable event was when the Prince Imperial, Nap III's son was killed in action. FTP the Prince Imperial was fighting against who with the British in 1879 when he died? \Zulus\
